13	group consisting of the Director of the Authority or his designee; the Director of the Department of Health	H
14	Professions; the Deputy Secretary of Higher Education; the Deputy Secretary of Labor; the Chair of the	U
15	Virginia Board of Workforce Development; one representative each from the Board of Nursing, Board of	
16	Counseling, and Board of Psychology; and the Chairs of the House Committee on Health, Welfare and	
17	Institutions and the Senate Committee on Education and Health for the purpose of identifying and proposing	
18	revisions to current regulations and policies that hinder the development, retention, and productivity of the	
19 20	health care workforce in behavioral health and nursing. The work group shall elect one of its members to	
20 21	serve as its chairman. The Division of Legislative Services shall provide staff support to the Authority. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Authority, upon request. In identifying and
