11	1. § 1. That the Department of Health's Office of Emergency Medical Services [(the Office) shall convene a
12	work group to EMS Advisory Board (the Board) shall] examine the eligibility requirements for emergency
13	medical personnel, both professional and volunteer, to join a professional program addressing career
14	fatigue and wellness established or contracted for by a statewide association as described in subsection B of
15	§ 8.01-581.16 of the Code of Virginia. The [work group Board] shall examine the costs associated with
16	joining or establishing such a program as well as make recommendations for payment of such costs. The [
17	work group shall be composed of the Board shall consult with] representatives of the Medical Society of
18	Virginia and all other stakeholders deemed relevant by the [Office. The work group Board. The Board]
19	shall report its findings and recommendations to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Health, Welfare

and Institutions and the Senate Committee on Education and Health by October 1, 2024.
