7 WHEREAS, Donald R. Craig, a beloved husband and father, dedicated social activist, and revered
8 member of the Orange County and Northern Virginia communities, died on April 20, 2024; and

9 WHEREAS, before moving to Northern Virginia in 2017, Donald Craig was active with a number of
10 organizations in the Orange County area, serving as president of the Parent Teacher Association at his
11 daughters' schools from elementary through high school, as well as with the Orange County branch of the
12 NAACP and the Democratic Party of Orange County; and

13 WHEREAS, Donald Craig was a devoted member of the Springfield District Democratic Committee
14 (SDDC), working tirelessly as a founding member of the organization's Postcards & Politics group, with
15 whom he wrote thousands of postcards in support of various candidates; and

16 WHEREAS, in recognition of his unwavering commitment and service, Donald Craig was previously
17 named the SDDC Member of the Year; and

18 WHEREAS, Donald Craig worked with both the Fairfax County Democratic Committee and the League
19 of Women Voters to assist voter registration efforts in his community, encouraging many to embrace their
20 civic responsibility; and

21 WHEREAS, Donald Craig gave generously of his time to advance a number of causes that were near and
22 dear to his heart through his involvement with various organizations, including the Faith Alliance for Climate
23 Solutions, the Fairfax County Communities of Trust Committee, the Poor People's Campaign, and the
24 NAACP, as well as initiatives such as a youth mentoring program in Springfield and local food drives; and

25 WHEREAS, guided throughout his life by his faith, Donald Craig enjoyed worship and fellowship with
26 his community at Metropolitan African Methodist Episcopal Church in Washington, D.C.; and

27 WHEREAS, Donald Craig will be fondly remembered and dearly missed by his loving wife, Tanya; his
28 daughters, Tiffany and Kisha, and their families; and numerous other family members and friends; now,
therefore, be it

29 RESOLVED, That the House of Delegates hereby note with great sadness the loss of Donald R. Craig, a
30 treasured member of the Orange County and Northern Virginia communities whose kindness and generosity
31 touched countless lives; and, be it
