WHEREAS, the Lake Braddock Secondary School theater program in Burke received “Best Play” and “Best Props Design” awards during the Fairfax County Public Schools' Critics and Awards Program gala at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts on June 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Fairfax County Public Schools' Critics and Awards Program, commonly known as the Cappies, is a chapter of an international program that empowers students to develop their abilities as theater critics; as part of the program, the student-critics present awards each season across 39 categories to participating theater programs and actors; and
