10	WHEREAS, as one of the first islands settled by humans in the Pacific Ocean, Guam has played an
11	important role in the history and development of the region while cultivating a vibrant culture that is
12 13	celebrated by members of the Guamanian diaspora all over the world; and WHEREAS, Guam was first discovered by Europeans on March 6, 1521, when Portuguese explorer
13 14	Ferdinand Magellan, sailing under a Spanish flag, sighted the island during his circumnavigation of the globe;

16	WHEREAS, Guam was subsequently colonized by Spain, and the Indigenous population became widely
17	known as Chamorros during the long period of Spanish rule; and
18	WHEREAS, while the Chamorro people remain the largest ethnic group on the island, Guam has become
19	a vibrant melting pot with influences from Spanish, Latin American, and other Asian and Pacific Islander
20	cultures; and
21	WHEREAS, now an unincorporated territory of the United States, Guam plays an essential role in
22	regional maritime trade and is home to several important American military bases; and
23	WHEREAS, Guam History and Chamorro Heritage Day provides an opportunity for people of Chamorro
24 25	descent and all members of the Guamanian community around the world to reconnect with their rich culture and heritage through celebrations that embody the Chamorro values of respect, community, reciprocity, and

20	WHEREAS, Guam History and Chamorro Heritage Day, which represents the start of Guam History and
28	Heritage Month, also known as Mes Chamoru, is a time for enjoying Guamanian cuisine and customs, along
29	with traditional songs, dances, stories, and historical interpretation; now, therefore, be it
