9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. That the Commissioner of Health shall convene a work group to study the occurrence of
12	microplastics in the Commonwealth's public drinking water and develop recommendations for the reduction
13	of microplastics in the Commonwealth's public drinking water. Such work group shall include
14	representatives of waterworks owners and operators, including owners and operators of community
15	waterworks, private companies that operate waterworks, advocacy groups representing owners and
16	operators of waterworks, consumers of public drinking water, and such other stakeholders as the
17	Commissioner of Health deems appropriate. The Office of Drinking Water of the Department of Health shall
18	provide administrative and technical support for the work group. In completing its work, the work group
19	shall (i) determine current levels of microplastics in the Commonwealth's public drinking water; (ii) identify
20	possible sources of such contamination; (iii) evaluate existing approaches to reducing microplastics in
21	drinking water, including regulatory approaches adopted by other states and the federal government; and
22	(iv) develop recommendations for the reduction of microplastics in the Commonwealth's public drinking
23	water. The work group shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the Chairmen of
24 25	the House Committees on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources and Health and Human Services
25 26	and the Senate Committees on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources and Education and Health
26	by December 1, 2025.
