A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 22.1-206.4, relating to public schools; school libraries; catalog of print or digital materials available in school libraries and used as instructional materials; development, implementation, and maintenance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-206.4 as follows:
- § 22.1-206.4. Catalog of print or digital materials available in school libraries and used as instructional materials; development, implementation, and maintenance.
 - A. As used in this section:

"Instructional material" means any print or digital material that is provided to a student or otherwise used in the classroom as a part of the school curriculum, including the curriculum of any course or program of instruction provided or offered to students enrolled in such school. "Instructional material" does not include academic tests or assessments or audiovisual materials.

"Print or digital material" includes any book, graphic novel, pamphlet, magazine, newspaper, periodical, or other written material or document that is available in a print or digital format. "Print or digital material" includes any such material that is composed of or includes drawings, paintings, photographs, or other visual depictions.

- B. The principal of each public elementary or secondary school or his designee shall develop, implement, and maintain in an electric spreadsheet or substantially similar electronic format a catalog of (i) all print or digital materials available in the school library and (ii) all instructional materials used as a part of the school curriculum. Such catalog shall:
- 1. Be developed and posted in a publicly accessible location on the school website in a searchable and downloadable format;
- 2. Identify each item by the item's title, author, and, if applicable, International Standard Book Number (ISBN), or such other identifying features or information as the principal or his designee deems appropriate; and
- 3. Be maintained and updated as necessary to accurately reflect all print or digital materials available in the school library and any instructional materials used as a part of the school curriculum.
