That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-289.3 as follows: \$2.1-289.3, Department; paid parental and family leave program for certain school board employees. A. As used in this section: "Child" means a newborn biological child or an adopted child or foster child younger than the age of 18. "Eligible employee" means any individual employed full time for at least the immediately preceding three months by a participating school board. "Paid family leave" means six weeks of paid leave at 50 percent of an eligible employee's regular salary to care for a family member facing a serious health condition or emergency. "Paid family leave" means six weeks of paid leave at 100 percent of an eligible employee's regular salary following the birth, adoption, or foster placement of such employee's child. "Participating school board" means a school board that participates in the program. "Program" means the paid parental and family leave program established and administered by the Department pursuant to this section. B. The Department shall establish and administer a paid parental and family leave program in which school board's means a school board that participates who are employed by such a participating school board shall, after submitting to the school board an application form approved by the Department pursuant to this section. B. The Department shall establish and administer a paid parental and family leave program in which school boards may opt to participate and by which

Participating school boards shall submit an annual report to the Department that includes the following data for the preceding school year: (i) the number of eligible employees in the school division, (ii) t he number of eligible employees in the school division who used paid parental leave, and (iii) the number of eligible employees in the school division who used paid family leave.

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
