10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. § 1. That the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity shall study small business set-asides
12	and their effectiveness in promoting the growth and economic development of small businesses through
13	participation in government contracting. Such study shall evaluate the impact small business set-asides have
14	on the growth of a small business, including the creation of jobs and development of new products or
15	services, and the extent to which such set-asides contribute to the economic growth of the Commonwealth.
16	The study shall also identify ways to increase participation by small businesses in government contracting
17	through set-aside programs and to ensure the successful transition to a broader consumer market of small
18	businesses utilizing a set-aside. The Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity shall complete its
19	study and submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly on or before
20	November 30, 2025.
21	For purposes of this act, "small business" includes women-owned and minority-owned businesses.
