**Bill Number:** SB965 **Patron:** Carroll Foy

**Bill Title:** Recording of proceedings in district courts.

**Bill Summary:** Allows an audio recording of proceedings in a district court, which includes both general district court and juvenile and domestic relations district court, to be made by a party or his counsel. Under current law, such recordings are only allowed in a general district court. The bill allows the judge of a juvenile and domestic relations district court to impose any restriction as necessary to comply with the confidentiality requirements applicable to such district court.

The bill prohibits judges of a district court from (i) ordering or require a party or his counsel to submit a copy of an audio recording made pursuant to this section to the clerk of a district court to be maintained in such party's individual case file or (ii) prohibiting a party or his counsel from providing such copy to the opposing party or his counsel.

The bill allows a party or his counsel to, in his discretion, provide a copy of an audio recording made to the opposing party or his counsel.
