Bill Title: Consumer Protection Act; prohibited practices, obtaining, disclosing, etc., reproductive or sexual health information without consumer consent.

Bill Summary: Provides that obtaining, disclosing, selling, or disseminating personally identifiable reproductive or sexual health information, as defined in the bill, without the consent of the consumer is a prohibited practice under the Virginia Consumer Protection Act.

Fiscal Summary: The Office of the Attorney General and the Department of Law (OAG) does not have an estimate for how many complaints might be received under the provisions of this bill but anticipates that costs associated with this legislation would be absorbable within current resources. The OAG notes that while an individual bill's impact may be absorbable, if the aggregate number of "absorbable" bills likely to pass either house is unusually large, it is possible the agency will require additional resources.
