Bill Title: Insurance agents; appointments and terminations.

Bill Summary: Amends the process for the appointment of insurance agents and agencies by insurers as administered by the Bureau of Insurance of the State Corporation Commission. The bill also revises certain requirements of an insurer or authorized representative that terminates an appointment of an agent that is found to have engaged in conduct prohibited by existing law.

Fiscal Analysis: The proposed legislation would eliminate the mandatory assessment of a \$50 late fee per day against insurers that failed to timely pay their agent appointment fees. The proposed legislation does not alter the State Corporation Commission's existing penalty provisions in § 38.2-218 of the Code of Virginia, which it can exercise if an insurer does not timely pay its agent appointment renewal fees.
