Bill Summary: Increases from five to 10 years for a second or subsequent offense the mandatory minimum sentence for use or display of a firearm during the commission of certain felonies.

Fiscal Summary:

Proposal requires "Woodrum" impact funding per § 30-19.1:4, Code of Virginia, to account for a possible increase in the need for state prison beds due to this legislation.

Fiscal Analysis:

This proposal increases the mandatory minimum penalty for a second or subsequent offense of the use or display of a firearm during the commission of certain felonies from five to 10 years. By increasing the mandatory minimum penalty for a second or subsequent offense under § 18.2-53.1, the proposal is expected to increase the state-responsible (prison) bed space needs of the Commonwealth. This proposal is not expected to increase the future need for local-responsible (jail) beds.

The impact on state-responsible (prison) beds is estimated to be at least one partial bed by FY2031. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is at least \$24,997. The majority of the impact would occur beyond the six-year forecast window required by § 30-19.1:4.
