Bill Title: Elections; absentee voting in person; availability and affirmation statement in lieu of identification.

Bill Summary: The bill limits the availability of in-person absentee voting to the 14-day period leading up to an election, reducing the current law, which allows in-person absentee voting starting 45 days prior to an election. Additionally, the bill removes the option for voters casting absentee ballots in person to sign a statement affirming their identity, replacing it with the requirement to present one of the approved forms of identification.
