**Bill Title:** Drug Control Act; Schedule I; Schedule IV.

**Bill Summary:** Adds certain chemicals to Schedules I and IV of the Drug Control Act. The Board of Pharmacy has added these substances in an expedited regulatory process. A substance added via this process is removed from the schedule after 18 months unless a general law is enacted adding the substance to the schedule.

**Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**Items Impacted:** n/a

**Explanation:** There is no impact to existing resources, nor is there conflicting language between the bill and the proposed Appropriation Act.

**Fiscal Summary:** There is no anticipated impact to state resources resulting from this bill.

**Fiscal Analysis:** The Board of Pharmacy has already promulgated emergency regulations adding the substances included in this bill to Schedules I and IV, and thus has already absorbed any costs associated with promulgating such regulations. Enacting a general law that codifies the designations for these substances is not expected to incur additional costs to the Board.
