Bill Title: Virginia Public Procurement Act; procurement of imported goods; forced and child labor prohibition.

Bill Summary: Prohibits public bodies from awarding contracts to acquire imported goods from a business whose products are on the list of products produced by forced or indentured child labor maintained by the U.S. Department of Labor Bureau of International Labor Affairs without a third-party certification provided to the Commonwealth. The bill directs the Department of General Services to promulgate regulations regarding such third-party certification by October 1, 2025. This bill is a recommendation of the Manufacturing Development Commission.

Fiscal Analysis: The bill directs the Department of General Services to promulgate regulations on third-party certifications that would permit a public body to award a contract to a business whose products are on the list of products produced by forced or indentured child labor maintained by the U.S. Department of Labor Bureau of International Labor Affairs. The Department of General Services indicates the development of these regulations would not incur a fiscal impact for the agency.
