Fiscal Analysis: According to the Office of the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court (OES), the estimated cost for a district court judgeship in the first year is \$312,202, which includes \$294,307 to cover salary and benefit costs, \$14,595 for a substitute judge, and \$3,300 in one-time expenses to equip chambers. The estimated cost for every subsequent year is \$308,902, which includes \$294,307 to cover salary and benefit costs for the additional judge and \$14,595 for a substitute judge.
