**Bill Number:** SB1356 **Patron:** Srinivasan

**Bill Title:** Fees for electronic fund transfers; prohibited.

**Bill Summary:** Provides that charging any transaction or processing fee or similar surcharge for the purchase of a good or service through the use of an electronic fund transfer is a prohibited practice under the Virginia Consumer Protection Act. The bill also prohibits landlords subject to the Virginia Residential Landlord and Tenant Act from charging a transaction or processing fee for the payment of a security deposit, rent, or any other amounts payable.

**Fiscal Summary:** The Office of the Attorney General and the Department of Law (OAG) anticipates that costs associated with this legislation would be absorbable within current resources.
