**Bill Title:** Photo speed monitoring devices; proof of violation; retired law-enforcement officials.

**Bill Summary:** Allows a retired sworn law-enforcement officer, defined in the bill, to swear to or affirm a certificate for a vehicle speed violation enforced by a photo speed monitoring device.

**Explanation:** Not applicable

**Fiscal Summary:** There is no anticipated fiscal impact on state agencies.

**Fiscal Analysis:** This proposal allows a retired sworn law-enforcement officer, defined in the bill, to swear to or affirm a certificate for a vehicle speed violation enforced by a photo speed monitoring device. While this expansion of people eligible to swear to or affirm a certificate for a vehicle speed violation could potentially increase the number of penalties able to be collected on, the exact impact is indeterminate.

Proceeds of all fines and penalties collected for offenses committed against the Commonwealth are paid into the state treasury to the credit of the Literary Fund.
