WHEREAS, Jon Stehle fostered the City of Fairfax's growth and development as chair of the city's Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and as a member of its Green Acres Feasibility Study Committee and Branding Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, Jon Stehle has made an impact across the Northern Virginia region and the Commonwealth as the president of the Virginia Municipal League and as chair of both the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCG) Food and Agriculture Regional Member Policy Committee and the MWCG Chesapeake Bay and Water Resources Policy Committee; and

WHEREAS, through his integrity, work ethic, and unwavering commitment to the well-being of others, Jon Stehle has helped to make Fairfax City a wonderful place to live, work, and raise a family; now, therefore, be it
