**Bill Title:** Limitation on prosecution of felony due to lapse of time after finding of probable cause; exceptions; competency evaluation.

**Bill Summary:** The substitute bill provides that the speedy trial statute does not apply if failure to try the accused was caused by evaluations or restoration related to his competency. The substitute bill defines insanity by referencing § 19.2-167 et seq. (Accused not to be tried while insane or feebleminded).
