**Bill Title:** Board of Education; accreditation requirements for professional education programs; exemption for professional education programs leading to certain endorsements.

**Bill Summary:** Directs the Board of Education to amend its regulations relating to accreditation requirements for professional education programs in the Commonwealth to require the Department of Education to provide an alternative to requirements for any professional education program that leads to certain administration and supervision and support personnel endorsements and has a secured specialty area accreditation from a specialized accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education or the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.
