Fiscal Summary: The Office of the Attorney General and the Department of Law (OAG) indicates that in order to carry out investigations and enforcements actions for this legislation, the OAG will likely have to engage in laboratory testing of food. The OAG does not currently have estimates for how much such testing would cost or the frequency that such complaints would be filed, and as such the fiscal impact for this legislation is indeterminate.
