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HOUSE BILL NO. 1828

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE (Proposed by the House Committee on Labor and Commerce

on January 23, 2025)

(Patrons Prior to Substitute-Delegates Simonds and Keys-Gamarra [HB 2133])

A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 38.2-3418.1:3, relating to health insurance; cost sharing for breast examinations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 38.2-3418.1:3 as follows:

§ 38.2-3418.1:3. Cost sharing for breast examinations.

A. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 38.2-3419 or subdivision A 1 of § 38.2-6506, and in addition to the 11 coverage required by § 38.2-3418.1, each insurer proposing to issue individual or group accident and 12 13 sickness insurance policies providing hospital, medical and surgical, or major medical coverage on an 14 expense-incurred basis, each corporation providing individual or group accident and sickness subscription 15 contracts, and each health maintenance organization providing a health care plan for health care services 16 shall not impose cost sharing for diagnostic breast examinations and supplemental breast examinations under such policy, contract, or plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in the Commonwealth. 17 18

B. As used in this section:

"Cost sharing" means any coinsurance, copayment, or deductible.

20 "Diagnostic breast examination" means a medically necessary and appropriate, in accordance with the National Comprehensive Cancer Network Guidelines, examination of the breast, including such an 21 22 examination using diagnostic mammography, breast magnetic resonance imaging, or breast ultrasound, that 23 is used to evaluate (i) an abnormality seen or suspected from a screening for the detection of breast cancer or (ii) an abnormality detected by another means of examination. 24

25 "Supplemental breast examination" means a medically necessary and appropriate, in accordance with the National Comprehensive Cancer Network Guidelines, examination of the breast, including such an 26 examination using diagnostic mammography, breast magnetic resonance imaging, or breast ultrasound, that 27 28 is (i) used to screen for breast cancer when there is no abnormality seen or suspected and (ii) based on 29 personal or family medical history or additional factors that may increase the individual's risk of breast 30 cancer. 31

C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to short-term travel, accident-only, or limited or specified disease policies, or to short-term nonrenewable policies of not more than six months' duration.

2. That the provisions of this act shall apply to any individual or group accident and sickness insurance 33 34 policy, any individual or group accident and sickness subscription contract, and any health care plan 35 for health care services delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in the Commonwealth on and after 36 January 1, 2026.

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
