Bill Summary: Directs the Department of Education, in consultation with the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services, to develop a mental health first aid training program consisting of an adult component and an adolescent and youth component. This bill is a recommendation of the Joint Subcommittee to Study Pandemic Response and Preparedness in the Commonwealth.

Explanation: The Department of Education would have one-time costs to hire contractors to develop the

new training.

Fiscal Summary: The Department of Education estimates \$15,300 in one-time costs.

Fiscal Analysis: The Department of Education (DOE) anticipates that contractors would need to be hired to develop the training required by this bill at a total estimated cost of \$15,300. This assumes 300 hours of work at \$51 an hour. There is no anticipated impact to the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services.
