Bill Title: Admission to bail; pregnant persons or persons who have recently given birth.

Bill Summary: Requires the court to consider whether a person is currently pregnant or has recently given birth and is currently nursing such child when determining whether such person shall be admitted to bail. The bill provides that if the judicial officer does not admit a person who has recently given birth and is currently nursing such child to bail, such person shall be transferred to and held in the local correctional facility closest to the child. Such facility shall be reimbursed from the jurisdiction where the offense occurred for any medical expenses incurred during such person's confinement.
