**Bill Title:** Department of State Police; Central Criminal Records Exchange; reports.

**Bill Summary:** Removes the requirement that the Central Criminal Records Exchange submit an annual report to the Governor and General Assembly on the status of unapplied criminal history record information and updates to fingerprinting policies and procedures. The bill also repeals a provision requiring the State Police to report annually on the list of governmental entities with access to the Department of Motor Vehicles' privileged information through certain databases.

**Explanation:** Not applicable

**Fiscal Summary:** There is no anticipated fiscal impact on state agencies as a result of this proposal.

**Fiscal Analysis:** This proposal eliminates two reporting requirements for the Department of State Police. The agency does not anticipate an adverse fiscal impact. Any savings from the elimination of these reports is indeterminate. This fiscal impact statement will be updated if new information is provided delineating any fiscal implications on the Department of Motor Vehicles.
