Bill Summary: Requires those legally authorized to sell Virginia lottery tickets or conduct charitable gaming, horse racing with pari-mutuel wagering, and casino gaming in the Commonwealth to post in a conspicuous place on their premises a sign that bears the toll-free telephone number of the National Problem Gambling Helpline.

Fiscal Summary: The proposed legislation is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.

Fiscal Analysis: There is no anticipated fiscal impact as a result of the provisions of this bill. The problem gambling helpline is currently printed on every lottery ticket sold, and displayed on the Virginia Lottery website, mobile app, and every vending machine. The number is also displayed at all retailer locations.
