**Bill Summary:** The substitute bill provides that for any discovery materials or evidence that the accused is permitted to inspect and review, the accused may request the Commonwealth to copy or photograph such discovery materials or evidence, including relevant police reports, witness statements, and the name and contact information of any potential witness. The Commonwealth is required to provide such copies or photographs, electronically or otherwise, to the accused or his counsel.
