Bill Summary: The substitute bill provides that if discovery is requested by counsel of record for the accused, the Commonwealth must provide such discovery by electronic means, defined in the bill, unless (i) such counsel of record requests a physical copy or (ii) such material is prohibited from being distributed by law or impossible to provide by electronic means. If such material is impossible to provide by electronic means, the Commonwealth must provide a physical copy unless such material is prohibited from being distributed by law. In any district court, the attorney for the Commonwealth is required to provide to counsel of record for the accused, if requested, a copy of any police report related to the case charged at least 10 days prior to the date the case is set for trial.
