

The bill also empowers the Attorney General (OAG) to investigate violations and bring action in the appropriate circuit court. The additional workload for OAG resulting from the bill is indeterminate and based

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on the number of reported violations. If OAG is required to increase staffing levels to meet the demand, each additional position would create an additional general fund expense of \$144,160 each year.

This fiscal impact statement is preliminary and may be updated if additional information becomes available.

Other: HB 2401 would create similar requirements but does not provide for enforcement by the Attorney General.
