Bill Title: Arrest of probationer without a warrant; timeframe for service of process.

Bill Summary: The substitute bill provides that upon the arrest of a probationer the probation officer shall, within 24 hours but no later than three business days after the arrest of the probationer (i) submit a copy of any written statement alleging a violation of the terms and conditions of probation to the local attorney for the Commonwealth and the clerk of court for the circuit court responsible for supervision of the probationer and advise such persons of his arrest and (ii) request the circuit court of the sentencing jurisdiction to issue a capias or bench warrant for the alleged violation contained in the written statement.
