Patron: French

Bill Title: Juvenile possession of tobacco products on school grounds, etc.; civil penalties.

Bill Summary: Prohibits a person younger than 21 years of age from consuming or possessing, or attempting to consume or possess, any retail tobacco product or vape product on a school bus, on school property, or at a school-sponsored activity. Directs that each local school board shall implement an educational rehabilitation program for any person who violates this provision. The bill adds community service for a second violation and fine of up to \$50 for a third violation. The bill directs the Board of Education and local school boards to amend any affected policies by July 1, 2026.

Explanation: The Board of Education can absorb any impact to update policies. Any impact to local school divisions is indeterminate.
