Bill Title: Phase II Utility; plan for certain generation and transmission infrastructure costs.

Bill Summary: Directs a Phase II Utility, as defined in existing law, to develop and file with the State Corporation Commission every two years a plan for addressing the risk of generation and transmission infrastructure costs associated with providing electric service to new customers that are data centers, as defined in existing law, being stranded with existing customers. This bill is a recommendation of the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission.
