**Bill Title:** Adding a member of the Department of Veterans Services to the Commission on Early Childhood Care and Education.

**Bill Summary:** Expands from 31 to 32 the minimum number of members of the Commission on Early Childhood Care and Education by adding one representative of the Department of Veterans Services to the nonlegislative citizen members of the Commission.

**Explanation:** Any additional fiscal impact can be absorbed; therefore no budget amendment is necessary.
