Bill Title: Board for Barbers and Cosmetology; employment prohibition exceptions; children 16 years

of age or older.

Bill Summary: Allows children 16 years of age or older to serve in a licensed barbershop or cosmetology salon, provided that (i) the child is an apprentice; (ii) the child is participating in a work-training program promulgated by the Board of Education; or (iii) the child has obtained a cosmetology or barber license from the Board for Barbers and Cosmetology.

Budget Amendment Necessary: No. Items Impacted: N/A

Explanation: This bill involves the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR) and

the Department of Labor and Industry (DOLI); however, a budget amendment is not

required.

Fiscal Summary: It is anticipated that DOLI and DPOR can absorb any impact that may result from this bill.

Fiscal Analysis: This impact statement is preliminary. The bill amends allowances for certain minors to work in a licensed barbershop or salon under certain conditions. It is anticipated that DPOR and DOLI will be able to absorb any at any impact resulting from the bill within current resources.
