| 6 | A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 3.2-5901.2, relating to State |
| 7 | Veterinarian; large animal veterinary grant program; report. |
| 8 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 9 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 3.2-5901.2 as follows: |
| 10 | § 3.2-5901.2. State Veterinarian; large animal veterinary grant program. |
| 11 | A. As used in this section: |
| 12 | "Large animal veterinarian" means a person who is actively engaged in and is licensed to practice |
| 13 | veterinary medicine pursuant to Chapter 38 (§ 54.1-3800 et seq.) of Title 54.1 and whose specialties include |
| 14 | livestock, poultry, or equine, as that term is defined in § 3.2-6200. |
| 15 | "Program" means the large animal veterinary grant program established by the State Veterinarian |
| 16 | pursuant to subsection B. |
| 17 | <i>B.</i> Subject to the availability of funds appropriated for such purpose, the State Veterinarian shall establish |
| 18 | a large animal veterinary grant program to provide grants to increase or stabilize the number of large |
| 19 | animal veterinarians practicing in areas of the Commonwealth that have been identified by the State |
| 20 | Veterinarian as having a shortage of such veterinarians. The State Veterinarian shall annually select from a |
| 21 | pool of applicants no more than four large animal veterinarians to participate in the program. |
| 22 | C. The State Veterinarian, in consultation with the Board of Veterinary Medicine and relevant |
| 23 | stakeholders, including the Virginia Farm Bureau Federation, the Virginia Academy of Food Animal |
| 24 | Practitioners, and the Virginia Veterinary Medical Association, shall develop criteria for applicants to |
| 25 | participate in the program, which shall include: |
| 26 | 1. The geographic area of the Commonwealth that an applicant serves or would serve and the need for |
| 27 | large animal veterinary services in such area; |
| 28 | 2. The number of localities that an applicant serves or would serve; |
| 29 | 3. The number of different large animal veterinarian specialties in which an applicant practices; and |
| 30 | 4. The percentage of time an applicant devotes to large animal veterinary services. |
| 31 | 2. That, subject to the availability of funds appropriated for such purpose, the State Veterinarian shall |
| 32 | establish the large animal veterinary grant program pursuant to § 3.2-5901.2 of the Code of Virginia, |
| 33 | as created by this act, no later than July 1, 2026. |
| 34 | 3. That the State Veterinarian shall submit a report evaluating the extent to which the large animal |
| 35 | veterinary grant program created pursuant to § 3.2-5901.2 of the Code of Virginia, as created by this |
| 36 | act, has helped to address the shortage of large animal veterinarians in the Commonwealth. Such |
| 37 | report shall be submitted to the Board of Veterinary Medicine and the Chairmen of the Senate |
| 38 | Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources and the House Committee on |
| 39 | Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources no later than July 1, 2030. |
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
