6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 22.1-274.7, relating to students with
7	disabilities; individualized education programs; individualized accommodations and supports during
8	emergency evacuations and situations.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-274.7 as follows:
11	§ 22.1-274.7. Students with disabilities; individualized education programs; individualized
12	accommodations and supports during emergency evacuations and situations.
13	A. Each individualized education program (IEP) implemented for a public school student with a disability
14	in accordance with the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq., with the
15	exception of such students who have been placed in private day or residential school settings, shall contain a
16	section addressing individualized accommodations and supports for the student during emergency
17	evacuations and situations as appropriate and identified by the IEP team at its next convened meeting at
18	which the parent is present and consents to implementation of the IEP.
19	B. The Department shall provide guidance to local school divisions on how to support IEP teams for the
20	consideration of specific supports required for students with disabilities, including students with mobility
21	impairments, during emergency situations given the unique context of their disabilities in the educational
22	setting. Such guidance shall include information relevant for IEP teams and applicable to Section 504
23	committees as determined appropriate.
