Bill Title: Consumer Data Protection Act; social media platforms; addictive feed prohibited for minors.

Bill Summary: Prohibits a person that operates a social media platform that has knowledge that a user of the social media platform is a child under the age of 18 from using an addictive feed, defined in the bill, unless the operator of such social media platform obtains verifiable parental consent.
