6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 2.2-2497 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Office of New Americans
7	Advisory Board; increase in membership.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 2.2-2497 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 2.2-2497. Membership; terms; compensation and expenses.
11	A. The Board shall consist of 18 21 nonlegislative citizen members appointed by the Governor who
12	represent or have experience with the faith community; local government; the U.S. Citizenship and
13	Immigration Service; law-enforcement agencies; health, mental health, housing, and workforce development
14	organizations; organizations serving youth and the elderly; organizations providing legal services for
15	immigrants; and educational institutions and institutions of higher education. In addition, the Secretaries of
16	Commerce and Trade, Education, Health and Human Resources, Labor, Public Safety and Homeland
17	Security, and Transportation, the Director of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion for the Commonwealth, and the
18	Chairmen of the Virginia-Asian Advisory Board, the Latino Advisory Board, the Virginia African American
19	Advisory Board, and the Council on Women, or their designees, shall serve ex officio with nonvoting
20	privileges. Nonlegislative citizen members of the Board shall be residents of the Commonwealth.
21	Ex officio members shall serve terms eonsistent coincident with their terms of office.
22	B. After the initial staggering of terms, nonlegislative citizen members shall be appointed for a term of
23	four years. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be for the unexpired terms. No nonlegislative citizen member
24	shall serve more than two consecutive four-year terms; however, the remainder of any term to which a
25	member is appointed to fill a vacancy shall not constitute a term in determining the member's eligibility for
26	reappointment.

C. The Board shall elect from its membership a chairman and vice-chairman. A majority of the members
of the Board shall constitute a quorum. Meetings of the Board shall be limited to four per year and shall be
held upon the call of the chairman or whenever the majority of the members so request.

30 D. Members of the Board shall receive no compensation for their services but shall be reimbursed for all

- reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as provided in §§ 2.2-2813 and
- **32** 2.2-2825.
- 33 2. That the initial terms of the three nonlegislative citizen members added to the Office of New
- 34 Americans Advisory Board pursuant to this act shall be staggered as follows: one member shall be
- 35 appointed for a term of one year; one member shall be appointed for a term of two years; and one
- 36 member shall be appointed for a term of three years.
