A BILL to authorize the Department of Conservation and Recreation to accept certain property to establish a state park in Loudoun County.

## Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. § 1. That in accordance with and as evidence of General Assembly approval pursuant to § 10.1-104 of the Code of Virginia, the Department of Conservation and Recreation is hereby authorized to accept [ or acquire ] on behalf of the Commonwealth, upon terms and conditions the Department deems proper, with the approval of the Governor and by deed in a form approved by the Attorney General, a conveyance from [ the The ] Conservation Fund of a parcel of [ up to approximately ] 1,240 acres of real property and any buildings or structures thereon between Little River Turnpike, James Monroe Highway, and Tail Race Road, known as Oak Hill Farm, in Loudoun County for the purpose of establishing and operating a state park [ that provides outdoor recreation and historic interpretation opportunities and supports agricultural uses ] on such property.
