

Any impact to DOE, state funding to K-12, and the Virginia Community Colleges System is indeterminate, not immediate, and depends on any gaps identified during evaluation and the need to bridge those gaps with programmatic changes that may or may not require additional funding. If local school divisions have to spend more on Career and Technical Education programs to meet any gaps identified by Virginia Works, increased prevailing costs could eventually lead to increased state funding. Any impact would be in a future biennium and is indeterminate at this time.
