**Bill Summary:** Prohibits state agencies from requiring as a condition of eligibility in state employment that an applicant have a baccalaureate degree. This shall not apply if the knowledge, skills, or abilities required for the position for which an applicant is applying can only reasonably be obtained, as determined by the appointing authority, through a course of study in pursuit of, and culminating in the award of, a baccalaureate degree.
