WHEREAS, in 2024, Christian Tabash of Alexandria represented the Commonwealth at the Games of the XXXIII Olympiad in Paris, France, winning a bronze medal for Team USA in the men's eight rowing event;

8 WHEREAS, a graduate of Gonzaga College High School in Washington, D.C., and Harvard University, 9 Christian Tabash is a dedicated athlete who previously earned a silver medal at the 2017 World Rowing Junior Championships and a bronze medal at the 2021 World Rowing U23 Championships; and 10

WHEREAS, Christian Tabash was selected as a member of Team USA's men's eight rowing team at the 11 end of March 2024 and helped lead the team to victory in the 2024 World Rowing Final Olympic & 12 Paralympic Qualification Regatta with a time of 5:35.97 the following May; and 13

- WHEREAS, fulfilling a lifelong dream, Christian Tabash qualified for the 2024 Summer Olympics and 14 15 was determined to help Team USA rowing win its first Olympic medal in the men's eight since 2004; and
- 16 WHEREAS, on August 3, 2024, Christian Tabash and his team advanced to the men's eight final and claimed a bronze medal with a time of 5:25.28; now, therefore, be it 17
- RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 18 19 commend Christian Tabash on winning a bronze medal at the Games of the XXXIII Olympiad in 2024; and, 20 be it
