6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 22.1-274.7, relating to students with
7	disabilities; individualized education programs; individualized accommodations and supports during
8	emergency situations and evacuations.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-274.7 as follows:
11	§ 22.1-274.7. Students with disabilities; individualized education programs; individualized
12	accommodations and supports during emergency situations and evacuations.
13	A. If deemed appropriate by the individualized education program (IEP) team, which includes the parent,
14	the IEP implemented for a public school student with a disability in accordance with the federal Individuals
15	with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq., with the exception of such students who have been
16	placed in private day or residential school settings, may contain language addressing individualized
17	accommodations and supports for the student during emergency situations and evacuations. In developing
18	such language, IEP teams should be supported by the school administration. Additionally, for initial IEPs,
19	the IEP team shall discuss whether or not the student requires such accommodations and supports.
20	B. The Department shall provide guidance to local school divisions on how to support IEP teams for the
21	consideration of specific supports required for students with disabilities, including students with mobility
22	impairments, during emergency situations given the unique context of their disabilities in the educational
23	setting. Such guidance shall include information relevant for IEP teams and applicable to Section 504
24	committees as determined appropriate.
