

At this time, the State Corporation Commission anticipates needing the services of a consultant to facilitate the creation of this program. Additionally, the use of a full-time employee in lieu of a consultant may be evaluated if the cumulative workload of this and other related bills were to pass.

**State Fiscal Impact Statement**

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The SCC costs to implement the requirements in this bill will impact its Public Utility Fund (02080). The current rate cap authorization (58.1-2900) as approved by the General Assembly (GA) is not sufficient to generate the revenue needed for the Fund to cover the costs of this bill's requirements. However, bills HB2663 and SB1336 have been introduced in the 2025 GA session to adjust electric consumption rate caps to fund SCC existing expenses and potential new expenses from electric utility SCC oversight legislation passed during the 2025 GA Session. The costs associated with SB1058 can be absorbed from the revenue that would result from the passage of HB2663/SB1336.

**Other:** House Bill 2266 is the cognate to Senate Bill 1058.
