WHEREAS, born and raised in West Virginia, Lloyd Enoch earned a bachelor's degree from Fairmont State College and a master's degree from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University before serving his country with honor and distinction as a cryptographer with the United States Army in Japan; and

WHEREAS, following his service, Lloyd Enoch devoted more than 40 years to the growth and development of young people as an educator with Roanoke City Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, in his role as director of career and technical education, Lloyd Enoch helped countless students prepare themselves for meaningful and productive careers and success beyond the classroom; and

WHEREAS, as a testament to his lasting impact, the Lloyd Enoch Social Gathering Area and Courtyard at the Charles W. Day Technical Education Center in Roanoke was named in his honor in 2024; and

WHEREAS, Lloyd Enoch gave abundantly of his time for the benefit of others as a longtime member of the Kiwanis Club of Roanoke, where he served as president and secretary-treasurer in addition to two terms as lieutenant governor of Division 15; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of his efforts and generosity, Lloyd Enoch was presented a Kiwanis International George F. Hixson Fellowship Award, one of the foundation's highest honors; and

WHEREAS, Lloyd Enoch will be fondly remembered and dearly missed by his loving wife, Rita; his son, Lloyd Jr., and his son by marriage, Jason, and their families; and numerous other family members and friends; now, therefore, be it
