10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 18.2-264 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 18.2-264. Inhaling drugs or other noxious chemical substances or causing, etc., others to do so;
13	distribution of nitrous oxide to persons under 18 prohibited; penalties.
14	A. It is unlawful, except under the direction of a practitioner as defined in § 54.1-3401, for any person
15	deliberately to smell or inhale any drugs or any other noxious chemical substances with the intent to become
16	intoxicated, inebriated, excited, or stupefied or to dull the brain or nervous system.
17	Any person violating the provisions of this subsection is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
18	B. It is unlawful for any person, other than one duly licensed, deliberately to cause, invite, or induce any
19	person to smell or inhale any drugs or any other noxious chemical substances with the intent to intoxicate,
20	inebriate, excite, stupefy, or dull the brain or nervous system of such person.
21	Any person violating the provisions of this subsection is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.
22	C. 1. It is unlawful for any person to sell, distribute, or offer to sell or distribute a device that solely
23	contains nitrous oxide to any person under 18 years of age for any purpose.
24	2. This subsection shall not apply to (i) nitrous oxide that is denatured or otherwise rendered unfit for
25	human consumption or (ii) any person or establishment that is (a) licensed to sell, serve, or offer for sale food
26	or beverages for human consumption; (b) engaged in the business of selling or distributing catering supplies,
27	food processing equipment, or compressed gases for industrial or medical use; or (c) a health care provider
28	as defined in § 32.1-127.1:03.
29	3. Any person who fails to make diligent inquiry as to whether the person trying to obtain nitrous oxide is
30	18 years of age or older or violates the provisions of this subsection is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.

31	D. For the purposes of this section, "noxious:
32	"Diligent inquiry" means a good faith effort to determine the age of a person that includes an examination
33	of any valid photo identification that establishes the identity and age of such person.
34	"Noxious chemical substances" includes fingernail polish and model airplane glue and chemicals
35	containing any ketones, aldehydes, organic acetates, ether, chlorinated hydrocarbons or vapors, fluorinated
36	hydrocarbons or vapors, nitrous oxide, or hydrogenated fluorocarbons.
