Bill Title: Public elementary and secondary schools; teacher; terms of employment; reemployment of

teacher who has not achieved continuing contract status; written notice required.

Bill Summary: Removes the requirement that, in the event of the noncontinuation of the contract of any teacher who is employed after a probationary period and entitled to a continuing contract pursuant to applicable law, either party provide written notice of such noncontinuation by June 15 of each year, and instead requires only such teacher to provide written notice of noncontinuation of the contract by June 15 of each year.
