Bill Title: Department of Environmental Quality; industrial wastewater; publicly owned treatment works; PFAS monitoring.

Bill Summary: The bill requires every publicly owned treatment works to mandate that certain industrial users self-report their use of PFAS. Upon receiving a self-report, publicly owned treatment works must convey the information to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) within 90 days. The bill also specifies that industrial users must submit their reports within 30 days of being notified by the treatment works, which must notify relevant users within 90 days of receiving notice from DEQ. Additionally, the PFAS Expert Advisory Committee is tasked with providing recommendations on PFAS testing and control technologies in its 2025 report.
